The Administrator is responsible for managing and overseeing implementation of the mission and for directing the resources of the Authority in order to implement the mission. The Board's role is direct oversight of the Administrator in his performance of these duties. The Administrator reports to the Board at each Board meeting regarding progress in implementing the mission, measuring performance and the existence or development of constraints, impediments or opportunities that affect the mission and its implementation.
